New Year, New Perspective, New Theme

Though we're in the midst of winter camps and ICE2CUs, summer camp preparation, promotion and recruitment has begun! This year our theme is "All Things New", which comes from Revelation 21:5; "And he who was seated on the throne said, 'Behold, I am making all things new.' Also he said, 'Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true.'"

What's the significance of God saying, "I am making all things new" instead of "I will one day make all things new"? And what does that mean for us in 2020? Does He mean that spiritually, right now, He is making things new? It would sure seem so, as 2 Corinthians 5:17 tells us He is. ("...if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.") There is a definite already-but-not-yet tension to this theme, and we want to explore both aspects.

Jesus can and will make us new, right now, if we repent, turn from our sin, and turn to Him. And He will, one day, make us FULLY new, in a glorified body that will never again experience the stench of sin or the decay of death! So, for kids and teens, what kind of newness does Jesus offer them? A life free from the terrible weight of seeing approval from others. A life free from the emptiness of temporary intimacy. A life free from the addiction to self.

The other aspect means future glory. It is hard to even imagine what awaits us the moment Jesus returns. It will be better than we can even imagine! Yet also, Hell is real and it awaits all who reject Jesus! The stakes are high in 2020, as they have always been. But we are closer to His return today than we have ever been. Time is short! We are not guaranteed tomorrow, let alone our next breath. We can begin being made new *right now*.

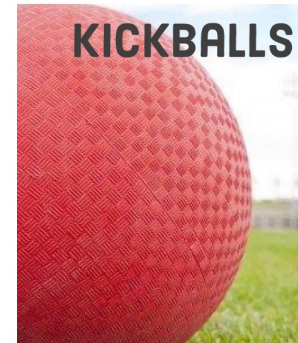
- God to bring some new speakers to fill the summer camp weeks for the younger ages
