SEPTEMBER 24-26

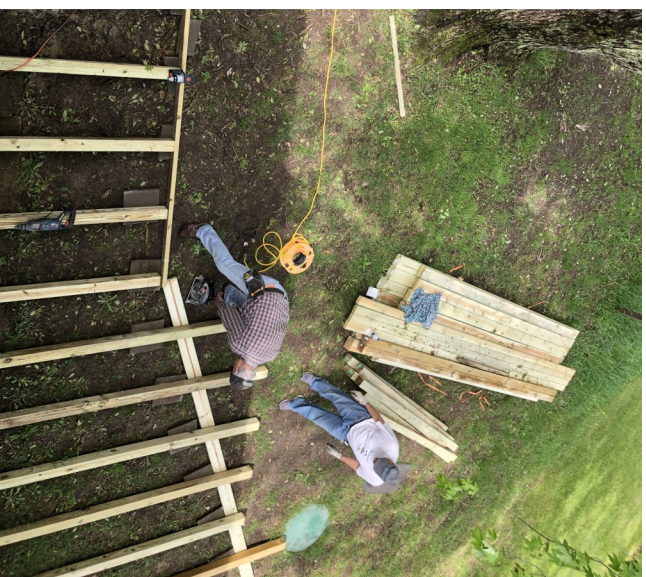
